Rockford. Exit at Route 53 (north) and follow to end (Lake  
Cook Road). Go west to Route 12 (1/2 mile). Turn right and  
follow Route 12 north to Miller Road. Turn left (west) to  
Arrowhead Lane. Turn right (north) to 125 Arrowhead Lane.*

**FROM NORTH SHORE:**

*Take Lake Cook Road or Route 22 west to Route 12 (Lake  
Zurich). Turn right (north) to Miller Road. Turn left (west)  
to Arrowhead Lane (1.1 mile). Turn right (north)  
to 125 Arrowhead Lane.*
